MArch I + MEM is a four-year course-based path of study that is suitable for students who do not have a prior professional architecture degree. Students can expect to gain both architectural foundations and environmental management expertise and merge these two domains during their course of study. This is the most common joint-degree pathway. MArch I and MEM are both professional degrees.
